
GENERAL INFORMATION

Observe the following


- Secure parts firmly.
 There is a danger of getting injured due to falling.
- 2. Do not use heat for drying after cleaning.
- 3. Never use petrol, benzene, thinner or any other such chemicals for cleaning plastic parts.
- Since cleaning of the unit accompanies a work at an elevated place, provide a sufficient protection against falling dust and for footing.
- In particularly hot season or when humidity in a room is extremely high, dew may condensate on inside surface of the unit.It must be wipe with a cloth.



HOW TO USE




- Move the shutter handle to the right all the way to keep the shutter open.
- If outside noise is bothersome, move the shutter handle to the left all the way to close the shutter.
- In heavy snowstorm, rainfall or typhoon, close the shutter temporarily.

HOW TO MAINTAIN (EVERY 6 MONTHS)

Cleaning frequency of the filter differs depending on whether it is used as an air intake or outlet. Clean more often if the filter seems to contaminate quickly.


Wall bracket

- How to remove
- ① Close the shutter.
- ② Pinch the knob with fingers and hold the wall bracket.
- 3 Pull the wall bracket to the front.
- Cleaning
- ① Remove dust and dirt from the shutter and around the wall bracket using a vacuum cleaner.
- ② Using a cloth dampened with a non-abrasive kitchen detergent, remove any dirt from the body. Wipe it dry with a clean cloth.



Main body

Remove the air filter according to the procedures explained in Air Filter, and remove dust on the main body with a vacuum cleaner.


clean cloth.

Air Filter

- How to remove
- ① Hold and squeeze the filter fixing spring by hand to remove it from the hooks (2 places), and let the spring hang.
- ② Pinch the filter from the top to remove.
- Cleaning
 Remove dust and dirt with a vacuum cleaner.
 - * If the filter is severely contaminated, immerse and wash it in lukewarm water containing a non-abrasive kitchen detergent, and then let it dry naturally. (Do not rub when washing. The filter may shrink.)



Hooks



Assembling after maintenance

- ① Attach the filter in the reverse order of removal. (The filter fixing spring should be latched to the hooks firmly.)
- ② The louver knob should be pushed in all the way toward the BOTTOM mark on the main body in order to mount the wall bracket.
- 3 Move the shutter handle to open the shutter.



- The filter should be washed every six months.
- The air filter should be replaced with a new one after washing it five to six times at intervals stated above. (Air filter part No. FY-FB12 (sold separately)
- Air filters are made of polyester. Follow local regulations when discarding it.
