- 1- This TRACK ACCESSORY is to be used with PROGRESS TRAK 1 TRACK only.
- 2- DO NOT attempt to power this TRACK ACCESSORY with any form of power supply cord from a wall receptacle, or to attach any form of convenience receptacle to this TRACK.
- 3- This TRACK ACCESSORY is to be supplied by a single branch circuit such as a 120 volt circuit with a grounded neutral.
- 4- Use of this TRACK SYSTEM with dimmers, timing controls, energy saving devices, special security switching, or other devices could create a safety hazard. Obtain professional advice before using this TRACK SYSTEM with other devices.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WHEN INSTALLING OR USING THIS TRACK SYSTEM, BASIC SAFETY PRECAUTIONS SHOULD ALWAYS BE FOLLOWED INCLUDING:

- 1- Read all instructions and TURN OFF ELECTRICITY at MAIN FUSE BOX, before installing adding to, or changing the configuration of the TRACK. Also disconnect electrical power at the fuse or circuit breaker, before servicing or relamping.
- 2- DO NOT install this TRACK ACCESSORY in a damp or wet location, or less than five (5) feet above the floor. TRACK MUST be installed in a location and a manner consistent with its intended use and in compliance with the NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE and with other, local ELECTRICAL CODES. TRACK must be GROUNDED to avoid potential electrical shock or other potential hazards. Polarity must be maintained throughout the installation.
- 3- DO NOT use this TRACK ACCESSORY for other than its intended use. DO NOT attempt to energize anything other than PROGRESS TRAK 1 TRACK from this TRACK ACCESSORY. To reduce the risk of fire and electric shock, DO NOT attempt to connect power tools, extension cords, appliances, and the like to this TRACK ACEESSORY.



WARNING! DO NOT turn on power until this FEED is fully installed in TRACK. Exposed CONDUCTORS become electrically LIVE and DANGEROUS immediately, when power is turned on. NOTE: This FEED will only fit into one end of TRACK, as shown.



- Remove COVER PLATE SCREW and COVER PLATE from FEED HOUSING.
- 2- Install COUPLING as follows:
 - A END CONNECTION Slip COUPLING into end of FEED HOUSING and secure in place with LOCKNUT and LOCKWASHER, with LOCKING SCREW pointing downward.
 - B TOP CONNECTION Remove KNOCKOUT from PLATE in FEED HOUSING, Slip COUPLING down into hole in PLATE and secure in place with LOCKNUT and LOCKWASHER. Insert PLUG BUTTON in END HOLE
- 3- Slip SUPPLY WIRES from end of CABLE, through COUPLING.
- 4- Slip 3/8" GREENFIELD or 1/2" EMT into COUPLING and secure in place with LOCKING SCREW. If ROMEX is used, place one CLAMP on each side of ROMEX, and slip ROMEX and CLAMPS into COUPLING. Secure in place by tightening LOCKING SCREW against CLAMP.
- 5- Connect GROUND WIRE from SUPPLY CABLE to GREEN GROUND SCREW. Connect WHITE SUPPLY WIRE to SILVER COLORED SCREW. Connect BLACK SUPPLY WIRE to BRASS COLORED SCREW. Tighten SCREWS securely.
- 6- Replace COVER PLATE and COVER SCREW in FEED HOUSING.
- 7- Insert FEED into TRACK as shown (SEE WARNING AND NOTE ABOVE), and secure in place with RETAINING SCREW.
