

Planning

Before you remove your old fixture, unpack the new pedestal lavatory and carefully inspect each part for any damage that may have occurred during shipment. If damage is discovered, contact your place of purchase. You do not want to discover damage after the pedestal lavatory has been installed. Until you are ready to begin installation, place the pedestal lavatory in a safe place to prevent damage. Check contents of carton for furnished materials.

Refer to the illustration on the front page noting fixture dimensions and locations of water supply and outlet. For new construction, refer to the dimensions on the front page for locating the supply stop. OBSERVE ALL LOCAL PLUMBING CODES.

IMPORTANT: Make sure the wall and floor are square and plumb to ensure proper installation.


NOTE: These instructions are for installing the lavatory to wood frame construction. For other installations, supply suitable bracing and fastening devices of sufficient size and strength.

- Wrench, open end,
 1/2" and 9/16"
- Pipe wrench
- Tubing cutter
- Common pliers
- Tape measure
- Pencil
- Drill
- 3/16" drill bit
- Level














Remove Old Lavatory

Turn off water supply by closing the two supply stops below the lavatory. If there are no supply stops, turn off water at meter. Turn the lavatory faucet on to drain the supply lines. Disconnect and remove water supply tubes from faucet. Disconnect drain assembly and remove p-trap.

Remove bolts or screws securing lavatory to the wall and floor. Move old parts aside.



Install Lavatory Framing Member

INSTALLATION

Rough-in the water supply lines and drain piping according to the front page dimensions.

STRIP


WALLBOARD SECTION

NOTE: Supply stop handle, in full open position, must not extend further than 41/2" from finished wall or it will interfere with the back of the pedestal.

Install the lavatory framing member at the position shown on the front page.

Install and finish wallboard section before securing lavatory to wall


NOTE: The lavatory framing member must be firmly attached to the wall studs. Lavatory mounting hanger bolts must penetrate finished wall and framing member a minimum of $1^{1}/_{2}$ ".



Install Pedestal Rubber Pads

Apply six self-adhesive rubber pads to the top surface of the pedestal as shown.


NOTE: The self-adhesive rubber pads may have to be repositioned to prevent direct contact between the vitreous china of the pedestal and the lavatory.



5 Install Faucet And Drain


Assemble faucet and drain to lavatory following manufacturer's instructions. Install tailpiece into drain body.


NOTE: In Step #12 the tailpiece will be assembled into the p-trap 1" to 2". The tailpiece may have to be cut to fit.



Install Lavatory On Pedestal

Carefully place the lavatory on the pedestal. Move the lavatory as required to ensure proper fit on the pedestal. If the bottom of the lavatory contacts any part of the china on the top edge of the pedestal, use additional rubber pads to shim as necessary.





Mark Wall And Floor

NOTE: Due to weight and size of pedestal and lavatory, the manufacturer suggests the assistance of a second person for installation.

Carefully position the lavatory, pedestal combination against the wall and on the floor at the desired location.

Place a level across the top of the lavatory basin, check level. Move the lavatory as required.


Be sure that the lavatory basin fits flush against the wall. The back of the pedestal should be approximately 55/8" from the wall.


Check alignment of lavatory tailpiece with wall drain. Move lavatory and pedestal if not in proper position.

NOTE: To ensure proper level condition of lavatory, recheck after any repositioning of lavatory or pedestal.

Using a pencil or pen, carefully mark wall and floor mounting hole locations.

Move pedestal and lavatory away from wall.






Drill Wall And Floor

At marked locations, drill two 3/16" holes in wall for lavatory installation.

NOTE: Drill deep enough to penetrate the lavatory framing member.

At marked location, drill one ³/₁₆" hole in floor for pedestal installation.



Install Hanger Bolts

Thread cap nuts on two hanger bolts (a). Using ⁹/16" wrench, screw hanger bolts into predrilled wall pilot holes until 1" distance exists between inside of cap nut and finished wall (b). Remove cap nuts from hanger bolts (c). Hanger bolts will remain in wall.

NOTE: During removal of cap nuts, if hanger bolt starts to turn, grasp unthreaded portion of hanger bolt with pliers.

Install Lavatory And Pedestal

Move lavatory and pedestal in position on the wall and floor. Lavatory hanger bolts should extend through the mounting holes, in back of lavatory. Pedestal mounting hole should be over predrilled hole in the floor.


NOTE: The lavatory must be supported by the pedestal. Place a washer and cap nut on each hanger bolt. Using \$^9/16"\$ wrench, tighten cap nut until the washers just contact the lavatory. Place a washer on the hex head lag screw and using $^1/_2$ " wrench, screw the lag screw into the floor until the washer just contacts the pedestal.

STOP

Check fit between lavatory and pedestal. Check level of lavatory. Make small adjustments if required.


Turn each cap nut until washer is tight against lavatory. Turn lag screw until washer is tight against pedestal.

A CAUTION: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN, BREAKAGE MAY RESULT.



Connect Water Supply


Connect supply tubing between supply stops and faucets following manufacturer's instructions.



Connect Drain Line
Ensure that tailpiece is installed tightly into the drain body.
Position trap nut and gasket on the tailpiece. Assemble the p-trap onto the tailpiece.


NOTE: Tailpiece must extend into p-trap 1" to 2". Tailpiece may have to be cut to fit.

Position gaskets against p-trap ends. Thread and tighten trap nuts onto p-trap.



Turn On Water Supply

Turn On Water Supply
Turn off faucet. Remove aerator from faucet. This allows any
debris in the plumbing to pass through the faucet without lodging
in the aerator. Clean any debris from screen. Turn on hot and cold water supply stops. Check for leaks at all connections and at faucet. Turn faucet on, switching between hot and cold several times. Turn faucet off. Reinstall aerator on faucet.



Clean Up

Clean up after installation, using warm water and a recommended vitreous china cleaner. See Care And Cleaning Vitreous China Lavatories on back page.
