

- Use a level to ensure that the center lines for the wall plates are vertical where applicable and the post center lines are horizontal where applicable.



#### 1. PREPARE THE SITE


**IMPORTANT!** Be sure all center points are level before drilling. There is no provision for later adjustment if the center points and resulting pilot holes are not level.

#### For Multiple-Post Accessories

**NOTE:** Take into account the length of the accessory components to determine the required distance between the post center points.

#### Locate the Wall Plate

### 1. PREPARE THE SITE (CONT'D) **Wall Bracket Hole Locations** ☐ Mark the vertical and horizontal center lines for each post. Use a level to ensure that all center points are level. Wall Bracket ☐ Horizontally align and mark the holes of each wall plate. Set the wall plate 2-3/8" (6 cm) D. aside. For Single-Post Accessories ☐ Mark the vertical and horizontal center lines for the post. Consult the "Roughing-In Information" section for dimensions. <sup>/</sup>1-3/16" ☐ Horizontally align and mark the holes of the wall plate. Set the wall plate Holes (3 cm) R. aside. For All Accessories □ Select a drill and 5/16" drill bit appropriate for the wall material you will be drilling through. ☐ Carefully drill a 5/16" hole at all marked pilot hole locations 2. INSTALL THE WALL PLATE Install the Wall Plate NOTE: You may need to disassemble some of the accessories. Some accessories will be packed with the wall plate installed in the post. Anchors □ Loosen the setscrew and remove the wall plate if needed. Wall ☐ In Wall Plate □ Plate AnchorsMounting Screws ☐ Holes ScrewsInstall the Wall Plate sert the wall anchor legs into the hole. Insert all wall anchors into the pre-drilled mounting holes. ☐ Carefully tap each wall anchor into the finished surface until flush. Mounting ☐ Horizontally align the mounting holes on the wall plate with the in-Holes stalled anchors, as shown. ☐ Secure the wall plate with the supplied screws. ☐ Repeat this procedure at each wall plate location.



# 3. INSTALL THE TOWEL BAR ☐ Partially thread a setscrew into each Escutcheon escutcheon. Wall Plate ☐ Place the towel bar assembly onto the wall plates. ☐ Tighten the setscrews. Do not over-Setscrew tighten. Towel Bar 4. INSTALL THE TOWEL RING ☐ Partially thread the setscrew into the escutcheon. Wall Plate Escutcheon ☐ Align the towel ring assembly over the wall plate. ☐ Tighten the setscrew. Do not overtighten. Setscrew Towel Bar 5. INSTALL THE TISSUE HOLDER ☐ Partially thread the setscrew into the escutcheon. Wall Plate Escutcheon ☐ Align the tissue holder assembly over the wall plate. ☐ Tighten the setscrew. Do not overtighten. Setscrew Tissue Holder
