
SUPPLY LINE: The minimum recommended line size is 1" IPS with 30-90 psi (2-6 ATM) flowing supply line pressure. Where sediment or mineral content is a problem, an inlet filter is recommended.

PLUMBING CONNECTIONS: Inlet supply is female 1" NPT.
