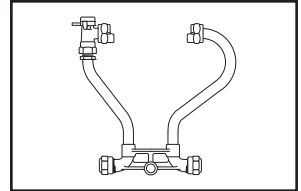


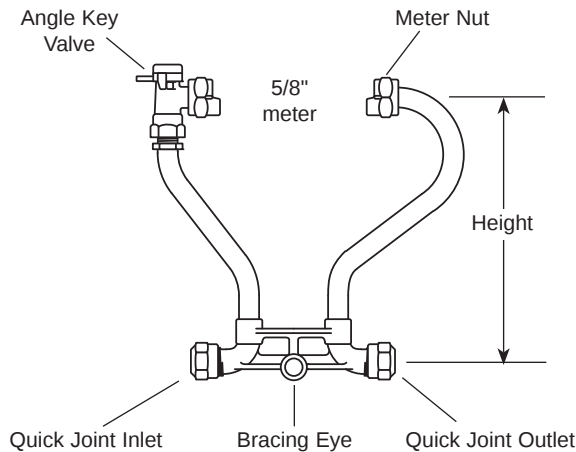

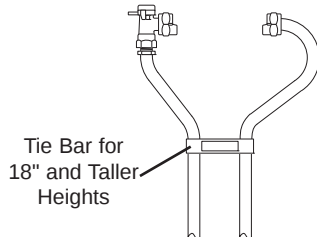
ANGLE KEY VALVE BY METER NUT (5/8" METER)
