Since 1998 we have over 100,000 users of our straps and are confident you will be another happy customer!

Shockstraps have several great features including polyester webbing, larger hooks, and of course our urethane based ShockStrap.

To engage the cam strap, it needs to be stretched  $\frac{1}{2}'$  or more. The ratchet strap can be stretched up to 2'.

All of our ratchet straps have a safety strap around the single or double ShockStraps. This has two purposes. The first gives you a redundant strap; if for some reason the ShockStrap were to break, the webbing would tighten and you would still have an attached strap. The second is to act as a limiter, so you don't over-ratchet.

Please ratchet until the webbing is tight. At that point, you will still be able to slide your hand between the Safety Strap and the ShockStrap. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.
