SMOKE TESTING

Routine smoke testing of the sanitary sewers will be conducted in your area on:

The testing of sewers using smoke is a standard method and is perfectly safe and harmless. The product used to test is odorless, non-toxic and will not stain. There is no fire associated with the smoke testing. The smoke used for this purpose will dissipate within a few minutes after it first appears.

To better prepare for this testing we ask all residents and business's to do the following.

- Pour water in basement floor drains
- Pour water in any unused or infrequently used sinks
- Flush toilets

Following the directions above will ensure that all traps are full of water and limit the likelihood of smoke entering your building through the drains.

During our smoke testing if you should notice smoke entering your building please remain calm as it is not toxic. If you do see smoke in your building please follow the directions below.

- Open doors and windows to ventilate the building
- Note the area where the smoke is entering your building
- Call our office at the number below to arrange for an inspection

Prior to the smoke testing please notify us if any of the following conditions exist during the testing hours:

- Dogs, cats or other animals that would be home alone
- Any individuals who may be alone or be frightened by the smoke
- Any individuals with respiratory issues who may be in the building
