


# SC351 How To

## Prepare for use


<p><b>1</b></p>	 <p>Unplug battery charger.</p>	<p><b>2</b></p>	 <p>Wrap cord accordingly.</p>	<p><b>3</b></p>	 <p>Inspect squeegee, brushes or pads then install.</p>
<p><b>4</b></p>	 <p>Fill machine with appropriate solution (temperature should not exceed 130 °F).</p>	<p><b>5</b></p>	 <p>Inspect ball float cage.</p>	<p><b>6</b></p>	 <p>Lower recovery tank lid.</p>
<p><b>7</b></p>	 <p>Get familiar with the control panel.</p>	<p><b>8</b></p>	 <p>Enable push-button and lever to engage brush/pad holder then release.</p>	<p><b>9</b></p>	 <p>Turn machine on.</p>
<p><b>10</b></p>	 <p>Choose program for the type of work to be performed.</p>	<p><b>11</b></p>	 <p>Press the solution flow control switch.</p>	<p><b>12</b></p>	 <p>Begin scrubbing.</p>

## SC351 How To Store the Machine

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>1</b></p>	 <p>Empty recovery tank and solution tank.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>2</b></p>	 <p>Rinse and wash recovery tank with clean water.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>3</b></p>	 <p>Inspect and wash, vacuum grid and automatic shut-off float.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>4</b></p>	 <p>Take squeegee off and remove debris.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>5</b></p>	 <p>Inspect squeegee, rinse and replace if needed.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>6</b></p>	 <p>Remove, clean and inspect brush or pad. Rinse with warm water. Hang to dry. Replace if needed.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>7</b></p>	 <p>Charge batteries.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>8</b></p>	 <p>Wipe exterior of machine with a damp cloth.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>9</b></p>	 <p>Lift recover tank lid to allow inside of the tank to dry.</p>

# SC351 How To

## Daily, Weekly and Occasional Maintenance

<p><b>1</b></p>	 <p>Clean brush daily.</p>	<p><b>2</b></p>	 <p>Clean squeegee daily by removing debris.</p>	<p><b>3</b></p>	 <p>Check each battery cell's water level (does not apply to gel batteries). Charge batteries daily.</p>
<p><b>4</b></p>	 <p>Clean tank and vacuum grid daily.</p>	<p><b>5</b></p>	 <p>Perform squeegee blade check and/or replacement weekly.</p>	<p><b>6</b></p>	<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; text-align: center;"> <p><b>Every 6 Months</b></p> </div> <p>Screw and nut tightening check. Perform this task after the first 8 hours of operation.</p>
<p><b>7</b></p>	 <p>Brush deck rubber pad check and/or replacement</p>	<p><b>8</b></p>	 <p>Brush deck end-of-stroke cable check and/or replacement yearly.</p>	<p><b>9</b></p>	 <p>Brush deck rubber flange check and/or replacement yearly.</p>
