



Be sure to read instructions thoroughly before beginning installation. Do not overtighten any connections or damage may occur. This faucet has an operating range of 20-80 psi.


Safety Tips:

Maintenance:


Your new Lavatory Faucet is designed for years of trouble-free performance. Keep it looking new by cleaning it periodically with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, and harsh chemicals as these will dull the finish and void your warranty.




Slide Hot and Cold Cold

A valves with washers and nuts. Hand tighter


Cold to the holes have been decreased. Secure end valves with washers and nuts. Hand tighten nuts onto shank. Lock nuts into position by tightening screws



Align tabs (1) and (2) on quick connects (3). Push quick connect housing firmly upward and snap onto receiving tube tab. Pull down moderately to ensure connection has been made. If it is necessary to remove quick connect, squeeze tabs on hose between index finger and thumb, then pull down to disconnect.



Make connections to water lines. Use 1/2" IPS faucet connections (1) or use the supplied coupling nuts (3) with 3/8" O.D. ball nose risers (2). Use wrenches to tighten connections. Do not overtighten.



Remove flange (1) and rubber washer (2) from pop-up drain assembly.

Add Teflon Tape (1) to the drain body (2). Apply the provided gasket or plumber's putty to the underside of the flange (3). Insert the threaded end of the drain body up through the drain hole and attach flange to the body with the pivot (4)pointing to the rear of the sink.

Unscrew the nut (1) from the pop-up body. Note: retain the seal (2) on the horizontal rod (3). Place the nut onto the horizontal rod and insert the rod and seal (2) into the pivot hole (4). Install stopper (5) as non removable (6). Slide nut (1) on and hand tighten only.
