

# Assembly Instruction Sheet #IS-SSSB1714VB For Style SSSB1714VB

Tools Required: Flathead screwdriver, Phillips screwdriver, pliers, wire cutters, wire strippers, electrical tape, safety glasses.

#### Estimated Assembly Time: 30-45 minutes

**Preparation:** Identify and inspect all parts before beginning installation. Check package content list and diagrams below to be sure all parts are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install, or operate the fixture. Contact customer service for replacement parts.

## $\Delta$ Warnings and Cautions

Turn off electricity at circuit breaker or main fuse box before installation. Consult a licensed electrician if in doubt.

These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important you read them completely before installing the fixture. We strongly recommend that a licensed, professional electrician perform the installation.


Disconnect fixture from power source before replacing bulbs. Make sure bulbs are given sufficient time to cool before removal. Do not subject glass parts to any shock while in operation or shattering may result.

## ▲ Care of Tiffany Style Shade

A new tiffany lamp shade has an oil film applied to the shade that protects the tiffany shade from scratches during shipment. If the oil applied is too heavy you can remove the excess oil film with a paper towel. Gently wipe away the excess oil.

For general cleaning of tiffany shades use a gentle lemon oil-based furniture polish applied to a soft cloth and wipe gently.

If a white powder appears on the soldered joints of the tiffany shade this is a normal oxidation process. Use a small amount of lemon oil or mineral oil applied directly to oxidized areas and the soldered area will return to like new.



#### STEP 5 - Install Shade and Bulbs

- A. Thread the Hex Nut end of the Nipple with Hex Nut (D) into the hex coupling underside of the Fixture Body (B). By using pliers, thread the Hex Nut against the hex coupling and hand tighten until snug.
- B. Place Spacer Tube (C) and Check Ring (F) onto the Nipple, secure by threading Small Knurled Nut (F) onto the Nipple. Thread the Big Knurled Nut (E) onto the Nipple and adjust it to proper location for rest components. Attach one end of Side Chains (J) to the Loops on the Fixture Body (B). Place the Shade (H) over the end of the Nipple (D) and attach another end of Side Chains (J) to Loops inside of the Shade (H). Thread the Finial (I) onto the end of the Nipple (D) and hand tighten until snug to secure the Shade (H). Adjust the Big Knurled Nut (E) against the inside bottom of the Shade (H) and hand tighten until snug.
- C. This fixture uses standard bulb with medium base. Maximum 60 watts. Insert bulb and screw snugly into place.

Your fixture is now assembled and ready to use. Enjoy!
