



## Instructions:

- 1. Read and understand all enclosed safety precautions before using test plug.
- 2. Safety glasses and hard hat must be worn during use.
- 3. Measure pipe to ensure proper plug selection. Never use a plug in a pipe size outside its recommended use range. Use only the proper plug for each pipe diameter.
- 4. Inspect plug for proper condition before each use. Keep away from danger zone when plug is in use.
- 5. Always use inflation extension hoses that allow plug inflation and deflation from outside the danger zone.
- 6. Never remove inflation hose until all backpressure is equalized and plug is deflated.
- 7. Always inflate to proper pressure indicated on plug. Use only properly calibrated pressure gauges.
- 8. Never exceed recommended maximum backpressure. Always release backpressure from pipe before deflating plug. (See safety manual)


## Safety Notice:
