
Observe all local building codes.

Unpack and inspect the items for shipping damage. If any damage is found, contact our Customer Relations team at 1-866-855-2284.


GETTING STARTED

3. Remove anti-jump rollers. This will need to be reinstalled once door is hung.




4. Determine a proper location on the top edge of the door to mount the rollers.







5. Reinstall anti-jump rollers using the anti-jump tool



6. Install the door guide. For a door that has been notched on the bottom, use the concealed guide. For a door with standard thickness, use the U-shaped guide. For thicker doors, use the adjustable guide.
