

11" CEILING LIGHT ASSEMBLY/INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Item #587519/587527: 11" CEILING LIGHT

Please read carefully and save these instructions, as you may need them at a later date.

CAUTION

WARNING: Risk of Fire. Min 90°C supply conductors. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor.

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

GENERAL

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustrations on the installation instructions.

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

Turn off the power at fuse or circuit breaker.

- 1. Attach the two screws to the MOUNTING BAR.
- 2. Attach the MOUNTING BAR to the OUTLET BOX with the MACHINE SCREWS.
- 3. Pull out the supply wires and the SUPPLY GROUND WIRE from the OUTLET BOX. Make wire connections using the WIRE CONNECTORS:
 - --- The black fixture wire to the black supply wire.
 - --- The white fixture wire to the white supply wire.
 - ---Attach the FIXTURE GROUND WIRE to the MOUNTING BAR with the GREEN GROUND SCREW.


Then connect it to the SUPPLY GROUND WIRE with the WIRE CONNECTOR.

Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box.

- 4. Attach the PAN to the MOUNTING BAR by inserting two MACHINE SCREWS and rotating the PAN until it locks in place. Then tighten the SCREWS securely.
- 5. Screw the THREADED PIPE into the COUPLING, then secure it with HEX NUT A.
- 6. Install bulbs (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 7. Attach the GLASS SHADE to the PAN by inserting over the THREADED PIPE. Secure it with a HEX NUT B. Then carefully attach the CAP to the THREADED PIPE and secure it.

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit breaker.
