
A. Trap Seal

Tools Needed


- Screwdriver

Installation Instructions

1. First clean the drain and pipe of any debris that could interfere with the Trap Seal sealing properly.
2. Insert the Trap Seal into a drain outlet or the throat of an adjustable strainer and push it in to the bottom.
3. Once in place, open the Trap Seal with your fingers to relieve any back pressure between it and the p-trap water seal. (Note: Installing the Trap Seal in the closed position will force water out of the p-trap.)
4. To ensure the p-trap water seal is fully primed, pour water down the drain slowly until the water level no longer rises below the drain.
