IMPORTANT

This guide contains essential information about maintenance and warranty and should be kept, even after your sink is installed.

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BEFORE YOU START

PLEASE :

- Check local plumbing and building regulations for approved procedures and use of appropriate accessories.
- Inspect the sink for potential damage. If you are concerned about a specific area covered with a protective film, remove it to verify the sink condition. After inspection, put the protective film back in place.
- Return the sink to its box until you are ready to install it.
- Determine the type of installation required (réf. page 28).
- If your countertop is made of marble, granite, quartz or a solid surface, you need to ask your manufacturer to pre-drill holes underneath to allow the installation of threaded inserts. Please screw the mounting brackets into these holes, ensuring that all brackets are used and evenly distributed between the sink's front, back, and sides. Please refer to your countertop installer for the type of hardware to use.

For best results, enlist the help of a professional installer to cut the countertop, install the sink, and connect it. Improper installation will invalidate the warranty.

Julien recommends that the sink be installed in such a way that it can be removed without damaging the countertop.

Please note that sinks with a front-to-back dimension of 18" may require a custom cabinet to ensure adequate faucet clearance.

INSTALLATION OF AN UNDERMOUNT SINK

PLAN AHEAD

Make sure the inside width of the cabinet (side to side) is a minimum of the overall left-to-right sink dimension + 2" to allow for bracket installation. Make sure enough space is left behind the sink for faucet clearance.

A printed cutout template is supplied with the sink and a digital format is available online at homerefinements.ca^{*}. We strongly recommend using the digital template to obtain the most accurate cutout possible. The dimensions provided are designed for an overhang installation.

The cutout template supplied with our SmartStation **REV**10 sinks allows for a 3/8" (10 mm) reveal installation. Refer to page 28 for more details on possible types of installations.





DID YOU CHOOSE A SINK WITH A LA CARTE OPTIONS?

If you have purchased a sink with one or more A la Carte options, you may need to make alterations to the cutout template of your base sink. See pages 10 à 15 for details about the adjustments required for your options.

UNDERMOUNT REVEAL FOR SMARTSTATION **REV**10

The default installation for our SmartStation **REV**10 sinks leaves a positive reveal of 3/8" (10mm) on the front and back of the sink and a 1/8" (3mm) overhang on the sides. This installation lets you place your sink accessories on the exposed flange, allowing the countertop to act as a stopper for the accessories. Our standard installations will guarantee a perfect fit with our sink accessories.



*Excludes À la Carte Home Refinements sinks ordered with the REV option. In this case, please refer to the cutout template supplied.



UNDERMOUNT REVEAL OPTION**

Choosing the REV option will extend the flanges of 3/4" at the front and back of the sink. During the installation, a positive reveal of 3/4" (19 mm) on the front and back of the sink must be created and we recommend a 1/8" (3 mm) overhang on the sides.

This option is necessary if you intend to use your sink's top flange as an accessory rail. It can also be added to any of our sinks that were originally designed for a standard 1/8" overhang installation.

** Option not available for SmartStation and SocialCorner REV10 sinks that are already reveal installed. No cut-out template is provided for À la Carte and Signature sinks. Confirm that your cabinet size will accommodate the bowl and faucet installation.



STEPS

1. Cut your countertop according to the template*. Plan ahead for threaded insert holes if you are installing your sink in a stone countertop. Consider using the digital template available on our website.



2. Clean the underside of your countertop and the sink flange.



3. Apply a sealant to the upper sink flange, then place the sink in the desired location.



4. Install the anchors. Verify that you are using the appropriate hardware for the countertop material you've chosen.



5. If necessary, remove excess silicone and allow to dry.



FINISHING UP

The drains offered by Home Refinements are specially designed to ensure the sink optimum drainage. We also offer a full range of faucets and accessories to complete your dream kitchen. Please refer to your sink dealer or visit homerefinements.ca to discover our product offering.

Once you've finished, remove the protective film from your sink. And enjoy!



INSTALLATION OF A SINK WITH A LA CARTE OPTIONS

If you have a sink with one or more A la Carte options, always start with the cutout template for your base sink, then make the necessary adjustments according to your chosen options.

UAF / UAC APRONFRONT

Home Refinements apronfront sinks are designed for a 3/4" reveal installation on the rear ledge, ensuring an optimal fit of our Home Refinements accessories on the sink ledge.



INSTALLATION WITH BRACKETS

Follow the installation steps for a standard undermount sink on pages 29 à 30. Please note that À la Carte sinks do not include cutout templates and as such, it is best to wait until you have your sink before cutting your countertop.

Apronfront sinks can be installed in several ways. If you decide to use a method other than the one recommended by Home Refinements, the countertop cutout will be different from the one illustrated in this installation guide.



INSTALLATION WITH SOLID SUPPORT

1. Make a 3-sided frame to support the flanges of the sink. The inner dimensions of the frame should be 1/2'' larger than the top of the bowl.

Measure the height of the apron, then install a support underneath.

2. Fasten the frame to the cabinet, leaving 1/16" free above it and ensuring it is level.



4. Measure the countertop. Refer to the sink to determine the cutout required for your desired installation.



DB1XX / DB2XX BUILT-IN DRAINBOARD

Use the diagram below to determine the dimension you need to add to the cutout template of the sink model you chose depending on the width of the drainboard you selected. Only the width will be affected by this change. The front-to-back dimension of the cutout will remain the same.



DW1/DW2 BUILT-IN DRAWER

If this is the only option added, use the cutout template of your base sink model as is. Refer to the technical sheet for the recommended cabinet.



REV UNDERMOUNT REVEAL INSTALLATION

If you've chosen a sink with a reveal option, add 7/8" (22 mm) to the front and back of the cutout template for your base sink model. Center your sink in the cutout with a space of 3/4" at the front and back so you have room for your Home Refinements accessories. The cutout width remains the same.



IS YOUR SINK A SMARTSTATION **REV**10 ?

If you have a SmartStation **REV**10 sink, use the cutout template supplied to ensure proper installation. The SmartStation sinks require a 3/8" reveal.



TF TOP-MOUNT/FLUSHMOUNT

If you've chosen a sink with a top-mount installation option, add 5/8" to the front, back, and sides of your base sink model's cutout template.



HPX HOLE(S) FOR FAUCET AND ACCESSORIE(S)

Ensure you have your sink to validate the hole location before drilling your countertop.



DVX **DIVIDER**

If you have chosen a sink with a 1"-wide divider option, follow the regular installation method for an undermount installation.

For a 4"-wide divider, use the diagram below to modify the cutout template for your base sink model.



ADA ADA COMPLIANCE

If you've chosen an ADA-compliant sink, follow the regular installation procedure for an undermount installation. Before installing your plumbing, plan for a tank depth of 5 1/2".

DPX POSITION OF THE DRAIN(S)

If you've chosen a sink with a relocated drain option, follow the regular installation procedure for an undermount installation. Plan your plumbing according to your chosen drain(s) location.

PRECAUTIONS

Acidic-based or chloride-based products: Stainless steel is vulnerable to hydrochloric and sulfuric acid, as well as other strong acids and chlorine-based products. Please do not use the following products :

- Construction chemicals
- Solvents (ex: plumbing PVC solvents, etc.)
- Photographic developing liquids
- Denture cleansers
- Grout and stone cleaners
- Silver cleaners
- Non-diluted bleach
- Household cleaners containing chlorine

These products can cause discolouration or corrosion. If one of the above products comes into contact with stainless steel, wash it immediately with plenty of water and dry it with a soft cloth.

Ordinary steel and carbon-based contaminants : Avoid leaving cans, steel wool, scouring pads (ex: S.O.S.), etc., in contact with stainless steel. These can leave small steel particles on the surface and contaminate the stainless steel, causing rust stains.

Corrosive food : Citric fruit juices (ex: lemon), damp salt, and vinegar, among others, should not be left in contact with stainless steel for extended periods as they can create corrosion.

Minerals: Saltwater can cause rusting on stainless steel that is not marine grade. It is recommended to use a 316 grade for marine applications. Jullien offer this grade through its Signature concept. Do not hesitate to contact us for more information.

Rubber mat: Do not place a rubber mat under your sink. Food, water, and cleaning products can cling to it and create stains.

CLEANING

Daily cleaning: Julien recommends using Julien Cleaner and Polish, available at your sink retailer, for best results. Otherwise, use a well-wrung-out damp cloth, previously soaked in soapy water, and wipe toward the metal grain. Rinse with clear water and dry.

NB: Home Refinements sinks are considered "flat-bottom bowls." Even if their bottom surface is pitched toward the drain hole to ensure adequate water draining, it is perfectly normal that some drops of water stay on the surface. Completely dry the sink to avoid water spots.

Oil or grease marks: Rub the surface with a cloth soaked in a mix of water and soap or water and detergent that is safe on stainless steel. Rinse with clear water and dry. If a stain remains, consider adding a solvent such as acetone, methyl alcohol or mineral spirit to the mix. Review the manufacturer's recommendations to ensure the solvent is safe on stainless steel.

Fingerprints: If a regular cleaning with soapy water cannot remove fingerprints, spray a glass cleaner or a household detergent on the surface and rub it with a soft cloth. Rinse with clear water and dry.

Neglected surfaces, grime deposits, stubborn spots, light discolouration, light rust staining, and water spots: Use a non-abrasive cream or a mild polish with a soft cloth or a sponge and rub in the direction of the metal grain. Rinse with clear water and dry. Be careful not to use abrasive scouring powders or pastes, which can damage stainless steel.

Heat stains or heavy discolouration: Use a non-abrasive cream, a mild polish or a scuff-free scouring pad such as "Scotch-Brit e[®]" (the blue one) and rub in the direction of the metal grain. Rinse with clear water and dry.

MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning: It is impossible to wear out stainless steel by cleaning it too often. It is even the best way to preserve its aesthetics and corrosion resistance attributes. Ensure you clean your sink before it requires an aggressive cleaning due to accumulated grime deposits.

Scratching: Even if Home Refinements stainless steel is a very high-quality material, it is still susceptible to scratches. To prevent scuffs and scratches, we recommend using a grid to protect the bottom of the bowl, available at your sink retailer. To mask scratches on stainless steel, gently rub the surface toward the metal grain with a fine abrasive pad such as "3M Scotch-Brite[®]." This will help align and blend the new scratch pattern with the original finish.

WARRANTY

Julien may, at its sole discretion, repair, replace or make adjustments to the Product or components proven to be defective to restore them to good working condition.

In no event, even if the Product or components are found to be defective, shall Julien's liability exceed the price paid for the Product. Julien reserves the right to inspect the Product installation before the replacement or repair of the Product or its parts. Julien may, at its discretion, require pictures before analyzing the claim. This limited warranty is null and void if the Product or components have been repaired, altered or modified other than by Julien or under its supervision.

This limited warranty replaces any other warranties, expressed or implied, including implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Laws governing product warranties may vary from one state or province to another. This warranty is not intended to contravene the public order and shall not be so interpreted. This limited warranty extends only to the original owner/end-user in residential applications and is not transferable to any subsequent purchaser. In the event of a warranty claim, original proof of purchase (sales receipt) will be required. Shipping and handling costs (for returning the Product or its components for repairs or to replace the Product or its parts) are not covered under this limited warranty is any labour, workmanship or other costs incurred in connection with the Product or components removal, repairs, replacement, adjustment or installation, and any incidental or consequential damages.

Attention

The warranty will be null and void for any damage resulting from an installation that does not comply with these instructions, and Julien will not be held responsible for any costs incurred. In the event of a limited warranty claim, original proof of purchase will be required—save the original sales receipt.

STAINLESS STEEL SINKS

Julien offer a limited LIFETIME warranty on the fixed components of its stainless steel sinks, ensuring them against defects of material and workmanship. This warranty is limited to defects or damages from everyday residential use. Julien will not be held responsible for defects or damages caused by improper installation.

This warranty does not cover the following points:

- Surface corrosion (chemical or natural)
- Scuffs or scratches
- Damage caused by misuse, abnormal or abusive use, neglect or negligence.
- Dents, deformations caused by the impact of any object
- Common signs of wear and tear
- Improper installation, care and maintenance
- Commercial use
- Damages caused by environmental factors
- Damages linked to shipping or freight
